Since taking over the hiring, training and scheduling for Mulligans and the Beverage cart I feel like we had more consistent coverage this season in those areas. I also feel like we have made significant inroads in the form of better communication with the restaurant and its association with our various leagues during the season. I continue to meet weekly with the now new GM at the Turnhouse to address any concerns or events that we have coming up in the future. Overall the feedback that I am receiving has been relatively positive.

Golf Report-

As we near the end of the season golf rounds continue to show increases over prior year. The Match Play Championship was completed in October with the defending champion Vance Welch repeating as the winner of the Championship Flight. Paul Littman won the First Flight. Participation for our member tournaments continues to be on the low side and we will evaluate options in the offseason to help grow these numbers next year.
